- •What was once the town of Riddleville is now Gillett.
- •What was once the town of Brackenridge is now Falls City.
- •What was once St.Joe is now Cestohowa.
- •The County Seat was moved from Helena to Karnes City in 1894-Vol. 2 Pg.220 of Commissioners Court.
- •The current courthouse was completed in October of 1894.
- •Affidavit of History on the fire-Vol.160 Pg.507
- •Probate Indexes 1 thru 5 and Probate books 1 thru 126 are located in section 5 of the rolling files.
- •Unit designations are listed in the back of the L to Z reverse index 1992-1997 and 1998-2003.
- •Survey books- 5 volumes and real estate books 1 thru 5 are located in the counter nearest the rolling shelves.
- •Official Records start with Vol.637 in 1993.
- •Deed Of Trust Indexes up to 1966 and Deed Of Trust are located on the book shelf along the front wall.
