

I am asking for your approval to move the existing Power Generator from the old jail to the Falls City School District Tower site located near the New Falls City Football Stadium. This Generator will serve as the backup power supply for the Emergency Services Radio System for the Sheriff's Office, EMS, and all four fire departments.

Holt Caterpillar Systems out of San Antonio has presented the following proposal.

Remove existing Generator, transfer switch, and equipment from the old jail site with the help of a Crane Truck and taking it to the Falls City site. This requires Holt to have an electrician remove all the wiring and transfer switch at old site and to have that person rewire and install at new site.

This generator currently runs on natural gas and Holt in their quote will convert the generator from natural gas to propane.

The County currently owns a portable building that was purchased back in 2012 that contains some of the current radio equipment at this tower site. Holt in their quote would pour a concrete slab to place this generator on near the current building. They would install a fence to secure the area around the generator, portable building, and tower. The concrete slab will be 44"x80" and the fence will be 30'x30'.

Holt has put in the quote to purchase a Propane tank and it will be installed at the site to serve the generator. They will be purchasing the tank from Smith Propane out of Floresville. The county will be responsible for the fuel for this system in the future.

This project is a win/win for all parties involved. The Falls City School District is providing the Tower, use of their land, and the utilities to run this system. The County would pay for the installation of the Generator to run this system in case of a power failure, the cost of propane which should be minimal in the future and the cost to insure our equipment in the future.

GVEC who has equipment in our building and on the tower will provide a new Air Condition system for the building (old one is in bad shape) at no cost to the county and free internet service to run this system at no cost to the County.

We are working on updating the current MOU to include the county equipment, use of property, etc. There has never been any type of agreement that covered Karnes County only one between GVEC and the Falls City School.

In addition the Sheriff's Office is spending \$25,000.00 of asset forfeiture money that is in the current budget to fund the additional radio equipment required to make this work as the back-up radio system.
