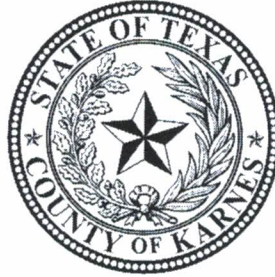

KARNES COUNTY OPERATION NOTICE:

County Clerk/District Clerk Offices: Will not assist citizens in-person UNLESS they have an actual court hearing on that date or a pre-arranged appointment. This will extend for a duration of up to eight (8) weeks. We will monitor the situation and determine changes or extensions as needed. We request all customers to call or email for assistance. The clerk's offices will still be operating, answering phones and processing e-files into judicial cases. For any other questions please call (830) 780-3938 for County Clerk and (830) 780-2562 for District Clerk.

Tax Assessor/Collector's Office: Will not assist citizens in-person but will be taking payments by phone, online or through the drive-thru. For all other office duties please call (830) 780 – 2431.

Auditor's Office: Will not assist citizens in-person but will continue operations by phone or email. For any other office questions please call (830) 780 – 2721.

Treasurer's Office: Will not assist citizens in-person but will continue operations by phone or email. For any other office questions please call (830) 780 – 2312.

County Judge's Office: Will only assist citizens by appointment and will be available by phone, email, or video conference call. For any other office questions please call (830) 780 – 3732.

Sheriff's Office: Will not assist citizens in-person but will continue operations by phone or email. For any other office questions please call (830) 780 – 3931 and select 0.

County Attorney's Office: Will be available by phone, video conference, email and by appointment only. We are available for protective orders, to address citizen needs and assist with anything we can but will continue to follow the guidelines recommended by the Governor and the CDC. Please call (830) 780-3736 for any other questions.

Justice of the Peace Offices: Will not assist citizens in-person and will continue operations by phone or email. They will take payments over the phone or online unless you have a scheduled appointment. For all other office questions please call your Justice of the Peace Office.

Election’s Office: Will not assist citizens in-person but will be accepting all election paperwork, voter’s registrations and any other documents by mail. For any other office questions please call (830) 780 – 2246.

Juvenile Probation Office: Will not assist citizens in-person but will continue operations by phone, email or video conference call. For any other office questions please call (830) 780 – 2228.

Adult Probation Office: Is open; however, is asking that you call your probation officer the day before your scheduled appointment to get updated reporting instructions as circumstances are changing daily. If you need to make a payment at the County or District Clerk’s Office, please mail your payment. For all other services please call for any questions. (830) 780 – 3394.

AgriLife Office: Will not assist citizens in-person but will continue operations by phone or email. For any other office questions please call (830) 780 – 3906.

EMS Office: Will not assist citizens in-person but will continue operations by phone or email. For any other office questions please call (830) 583-9237.

Maintenance Office: Will not assist citizens in-person but will continue operations by phone or email. For any other office questions please call (830) 623-1476.

Special Project/911 Addressing/Permits Office: Will be limiting resident and business access to appointment only. Please call (830) 780-3511 or (830) 399-9741 during normal business hours. We encourage the use of our website for permit/911 address applications, email is the preferred method for delivery.

Driver’s License Office: Will be temporarily closed due to Governor Abbott’s announcement on March 18, 2020.
