

Did you know.....

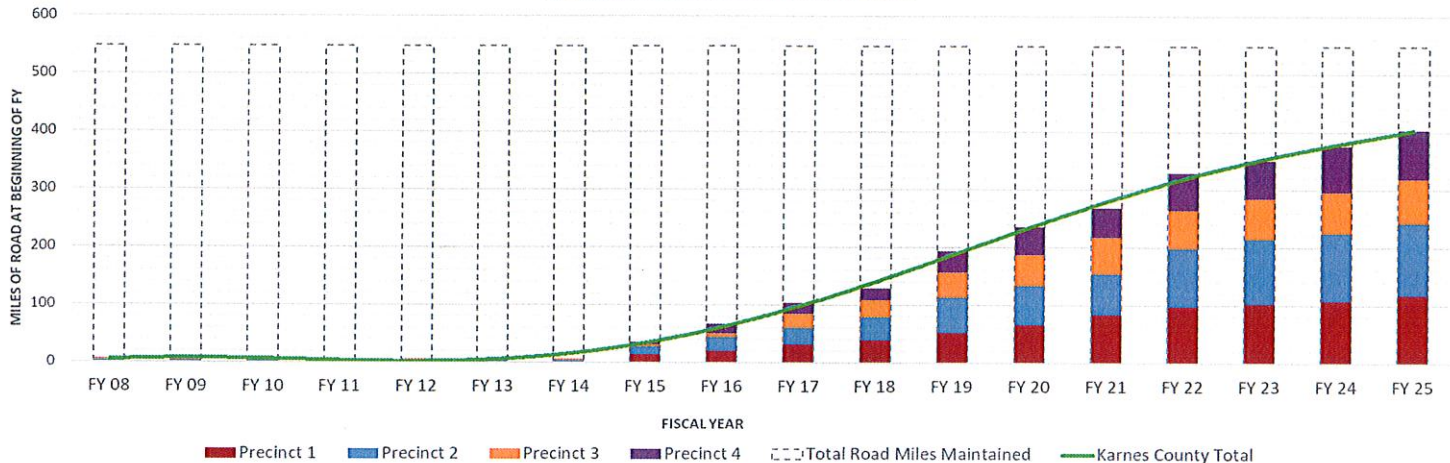
....that Karnes County Road & Bridge maintains approximately 550 miles of roads?

That's enough roads to reach all the way to Amarillo! What's more, prior to 2015 only about five miles were paved...and they were in pretty poor shape.

Today, thanks to our financial health, consolidation of resources through the Unit System, and a combination of in-house expertise and strategic outsourcing our paved road inventory is over 400 miles. And all the roads built since 2018 have also improved drainage. And all have been designed in-house (with the exception of a few bridges), saving Karnes County hundreds of thousands of dollars.
